INTRODUCTION

Electric actuators, ON-OFF type, to be mounted on the fluid shut-off devices (radiator valves, manifolds for heating and/or air conditioning systems.

It is not possible to replace the power supply cable of this device; if the cable is damaged, the control device should be discarded.

APPLICATIONS

Operation is of the ON-OFF type, normally controllable via room thermostat. In the version with microswitch (4-wire) a contact, is provided normally closed (version NC), with the actuator not energized, having a max. applicable load of 700 mA inductive and 3A resistive.

OPERATION

Normally closed version (NC)


When mounting the actuator on the valve body, the valve plug shuts off the flow of fluid. When voltage is applied a linear movement of the thermostatic element is caused the valve plug opens which then allows the fluid to flow. When the voltage is removed, the valve plug is closed again.

Red = valve plug closed - Black = valve plug open

ASSEMBLY

- 1. remove the protective cap, if present, or handwheel from the valve
- 2. screw-in the actuator ring nut by hand on the threaded part of the valve body and lock it
- 3. connect the wires to the electrical equipment

WARNING NEVER OPEN THE ACTUATOR BODY CASING EVEN OF FAILURE, AS THIS COULD CAUSE INJURY
